PUBLIC NOTICE OF STORM WATER DISCHARGE

The Iowa Department of Transportation plans to submit a Notice of Intent to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit No.2 "Storm Water Discharge Associated with Industrial Activity for Construction Activities."

The storm water discharge will be from construction activity located in Franklin County on US 65. The project is bridge replacement over Spring Creek, approx. 1.3 miles north of IA 3.

The Public Lands Survey location is Township 92N, Range 20W, Sections 21/22.

Storm water will be discharged from 4 point sources and will be discharged into the following streams: ditches to Spring Creek to Hartgrave Creek.

Comments may be submitted to the Storm Water Discharge Coordinator, IOWA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, Environmental Protection Division, 502 E Ninth St., Des Moines, IA 50319-0034. The public may review the Notice of Intent from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday at the above address after it has been received by the Department.
