A Departmental Meeting/Safety Committee Meeting was held.

Anthony Vaughn and Erik Jensen, Alliant Energy representatives, met to update the Board on the new windfarm construction in northwest Franklin County. All construction will be done by Thanksgiving and the full commercial operation will become on-line after the first of the year. Reclamation-moving rock is about half done and they're trying to stay right behind the crane. Reclaiming the rock will not be completed this winter, but they will be back in the spring to address the road rock. The last road closure was today for the crane crossing, unless it is needed. The operations aspect will have a two year warranty through GE once all turbines are on-line.

Limited discussion on contacting the livestock industry regarding effects of industry on Franklin County Infrastructure was mentioned.
