OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS UNAPPROVED MINUTES DECEMBER 16, 2019

Be it duly noted these minutes of Dec. 16, 2019 are UNOFFICIAL minutes.

The Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30 a.m., with Board members Corey Eberling-Chairman, Gary McVicker and Mike Nolte present.

Chairman Eberling led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by McVicker, seconded by Nolte, approves the Agenda as submitted. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Nolte, seconded by McVicker, approves the Minutes of Dec. 9, 2019. All ayes. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Gabe Johanns, IT Director, notified the Board he will be helping with NIACC job fairs and training sessions.

Committee Updates: Sheriff Department's need of mobile and hand-held radios; update on Public Health tuberculosis outbreak at the Hampton-Dumont Community School; CIJD regular meeting update; NIACOG Executive Committee; Workforce Development Area II meeting;

The Board met with Jay Waddingham, County Engineer, no action items.

Vicki Pralle and Patti Hanson, Iowa Workforce Development Grant, gave an update. Three people were working through NIACC to help with Secondary Road's transport of rock. Hanson reported that Franklin County is a leader with this type of Workforce Grant as provided through NIACC.

Jenny Backer, Access, Inc., met to request funding for FY2021 Budget. No action taken.

Charlie Brown, Treasurer and Barry Johnson, Representatives from the Franklin County Historical Society, met to request funding for FY2021 Budget. No action taken.

At 11 a.m., Art Cady, Franklin County Drainage Attorney, met to go over DD #48 Court Ruling Nos. CVCV50188 and EQCV501611; Lemkes/Blackfords vs DD#48 Trustees and Drainage District.

Motion by McVicker, seconded by Nolte, at 11:04 a.m., moves to go into closed session per Iowa Code Chapter 21.5(c) To discuss strategy with counsel in matters that are presently in litigation or where litigation is imminent where its disclosure would be likely to prejudice or disadvantage the position of the governmental body in that litigation. Present in closed session was: Supervisors Corey Eberling, Gary McVicker, Mike Nolte, Auditor Michelle Giddings, Drainage Attorney Art Cady and Clapsaddle Garber Drainage Engineer Lee Gallentine. Eberling-Aye, McVicker-Aye, Nolte-Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Nolte, seconded by McVicker, at 11:39 a.m., moves to come out of closed session. Eberling-Aye, McVicker-Aye, Nolte-Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by McVicker, seconded by Nolte, moves to not appeal the DD #48 Court Ruling Nos. CVCV50188 and EQCV501611; between Lemkes/Blackfords vs DD#48 Trustees, per recommendation of Drainage Attorney Cady.

All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by McVicker, seconded by Nolte, moves to initiate the Court Ordered Ruling and divide DD #48 into two separate drainage districts and proceed with new reclassification schedules using the additional usage factor per the Courts opinion. Per this decision, authorizing Clapsaddle Garber to proceed with the reclassification schedules in a timely fashion so as to relevy the new districts in the spring of 2020. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by McVicker, seconded by Nolte, approves Hampton Chronicle and Sheffield Press as Official Newspapers in Franklin County for 20/21. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by McVicker, seconded by Nolte, approves claims for period ending Dec. 15, 2019. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Nolte, seconded by McVicker, adjourns at 12:03 p.m., until Dec. 23, 2019. All ayes. Motion carried.
