CITY OF SHEFFIELD PUBLIC MEASURE (HW)

SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED:

To authorize a change in the use of the one percent (1%) local sales and service tax in the City of Sheffield effective on March 1, 2020.

Revenues from the sales and services tax are currently allocated as:

- Sixty percent (60%) allocated to city streets.
- Twenty percent (20%) allocated to the city water system.
- Twenty percent (20%) allocated to the city sewage system.

Revenues are currently expended on maintenance, repair and construction of city streets, public water system and public sewage system.

If the change is approved, revenues from the sales and services tax shall be allocated as:

- Sixty percent (60%) allocated directly for the maintenance, repair and construction of city streets.
- Forty percent (40%) allocated to the general fund to be used for any lawful purposes of the City.

The specific purposes for which the revenues shall be expended are for the public safety, maintenance, repair and construction of any public property and infrastructure, community planning services, public library uses, and administrative functions. All expenditures will be subject to regular audit, public comment, and review as provided by and consistent with the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sheffield and Iowa law.
