Heather Taylor, USPS Post Mistress, provided details on an unannounced route delivery change in SW Hampton which has generated numerous citizen complaints. Also providing details were Stephanie Brant and Dawn Cook with the USPS (via Zoom). The USPS made the decision to discontinue door delivery to 22 properties due to the recent dog incident at 203 6th St SW without providing written notice to the properties. Effected residents now are required to pick up their mail at the post office until such time as they install the required curbside mailbox at their own expense. The USPS representatives stated that anyone with a medical issue may apply for an exemption. Many neighboring property owners voiced their opposition to the USPS decision as it is an inconvenience and potential expense for 22 properties due to 1 dog owner's actions. They do not feel they should be punished. The USPS explained that their number one priority is postal carrier safety. In order to ensure carrier safety, they feel this change is necessary. Post Mistress Taylor admitted she failed to provide written notification to the effected residences prior to discontinuing door delivery. City council members expressed their frustrations that they were not provided all of the facts at the vicious dog hearing which led to this USPS

decision. Mayor Wood called for a motion to approve claims. Motion by Birdsall, seconded by Palmer to approve claims, as recommended by Staff, totaling \$796,216.27. Motion approved unanimously.

Scott Stillwell. 121 2nd Ave SE stated that he has seen a reduction of the transient issues and his frustra-

tions with the system being broken at the top level. Rich Hugeback, 621 3rd Ave SW, is willing to donate towards a chain link fence for the dogs that were the subject of a vicious dog hearing at the last council meetina.
