HAMPTON CITY COUNCIL REGULAR SESSION MINUTES THURSDAY, MAY 27, 2021, 6:00 P.M.
THE HAMPTON CITY COUNCIL REGULAR SESSION WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT THE FRANKLIN COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER BY MAYOR RUSSELL WOOD AT 6:00 P.M. COUNCIL MEMBERS IN ATTENDANCE WERE BARRY LAMOS, JAMES DAVIES, RICHARD LUKENSMEYER, BILL HODGE, PATRICK PALMER AND STEVE BIRDSALL. MAYOR WOOD INVITED THOSE PRESENT TO JOIN IN THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE U.S. FLAG. MAYOR WOOD CALLED FOR A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA. MOTION BY DAVIES. SECOND BY HODGE. MOTION APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY.
Council Workshop report: Mayor Wood presented the minutes from the May 24, 2021 Council Workshop and noted that final route for the Iowa River Riders UTV Poker Run mentioned in the minutes did not include Hampton so it is not on the May 27 agenda as noted in workshop minutes.
Public Hearing: Mayor Wood opened the Public Hearing in regard to the amendment to the Fiscal Year 2020-21 Budget at 6:01 pm. City Manager Dunt reviewed the details. No comments were received from the public and Mayor Wood closed the public hearing at 6:02 pm. Motion by Birdsall, second by Lamos to approve Resolution 2021-16 "A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2021". Roll Call Vote. Ayes: Davies, Birdsall, Lukensmeyer, Palmer, Hodge, and Lamos. Nays: None. Resolution 2021-16 approved and adopted.

Old Business: None.
New Business: Mark Crawford, Crawford Engineering presented contract and bond for 2021-2022 HMA Street Overlay Improvements Project and recommended approval of the construction contract and bond. Motion by Lukensmeyer, second by Davies to approve Resolution 2021-17 "RESOLUTION APPROVING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT AND BOND FOR THE 2021-2022 HMA STREET OVERLAY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT". Roll call vote. Ayes: Hodge, Davies, Palmer, Lukensmeyer, Lamos and Birdsall. Nays: none. Resolution 2021-17 approved and adopted.
Chief Schaefer presented details of an incident involving a mail carrier and a dog owned by Jenny Turner of 203 6th St. SW, Hampton. Ms. Turner and her sons, Cody and Nick, also of 203 6th St. SW, requested that the dog be given another chance. Statements from the mail carrier involved and a neighbor who witnessed the incident were also read. Motion by Lamos, second by Lukensmeyer to declare the dog in question (Jay, a brown and white terrier mix) as non-violent. The dog will stay out of town until an underground fence is completed as a back-up to the leash and the police chief is notified. Roll call vote.
Ayes: Lukensmeyer, Davies, Hodge, and Lamos. Nays: Birdsall and Palmer. Motion approved.
City Manager Dunt reviewed details of a request for stop signs in the Southeast quadrant of Hampton. The city council received a petition for stop signs on 1st Ave SE at the intersections of 5th, 6th 7th and 8th Streets. In researching the request, the city council took into consideration the concerns of those who signed the petition, and reviewed and discussed the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), which states that

many factors are to be considered when determining signage including traffic volume, traffic visibility and crash data. Motion by Palmer to put stop signs on 1st Ave SE at the intersections of 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th Streets SE. Motion died for lack of a second.
Mayor Wood called for a motion to approve claims. Motion by Davies, seconded by Birdsall to approve claims, as recommended by Staff, totaling \$134,114.64. Motion approved unanimously.
Consideration of Approval and Adoption of the Ordinances/Resolutions: Franklin County EMA Coordinator, Joel McWilliams presented details of the county wide multi-jurisdictional multi-hazard mitigation plan. Motion by Lukensmeyer, second by Davies to approve Resolution 2021-14 "A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HAMPTON, IOWA ADOPTING A COUNTY WIDE MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FOR THE INCORPORATED AREAS OF THE CITY." Roll call vote. Ayes: Hodge, Lamos, Lukensmeyer, Birdsall, Palmer, and Davies. Nays: none. Resolution 2021-14 approved and adopted.
City Manager Dunt provided details of Resolution 2021-15 "RESOLUTION ADOPTING RECORDS RETENTION POLICY". Motion by Birdsall, second by Hodge to approve Resolution 2021-15. Roll call vote. Ayes: Birdsall, Hodge, Palmer, Lamos, Lukensmeyer and Davies. Nays: None. Resolution 2021-15 approved and adopted.
Motion by Palmer, seconded by Birdsall to approve the Consent Agenda, including Previous minutes as drafted from the Thursday, May 13, 2021, Regular Session; scheduling the next Regular Session for Thursday, June 10, 2021, at 6:00 p.m. at Franklin County Law Enforcement Center; approving renewal of Alcohol Licensing for Kum

& Go #1, 609 Central Ave W, Hampton, IA; approving amended area for fair beer garden special license for Franklin County Agricultural & Fair Association, 1020 Central Ave W, Hampton, IA; and approving renewal of Cigarette and Tobacco Licensing for Casey's General Store, 719 4th St NE, Hampton, Iowa; Kum & Go #0001, 609 Central Ave W, Hampton, Iowa; Fareway Stores, Inc. #902, 309 Central Ave W, Hampton, Iowa; Kwik Star #567, 300 Central Ave W, Hampton, Iowa. Motion approved unanimously.
